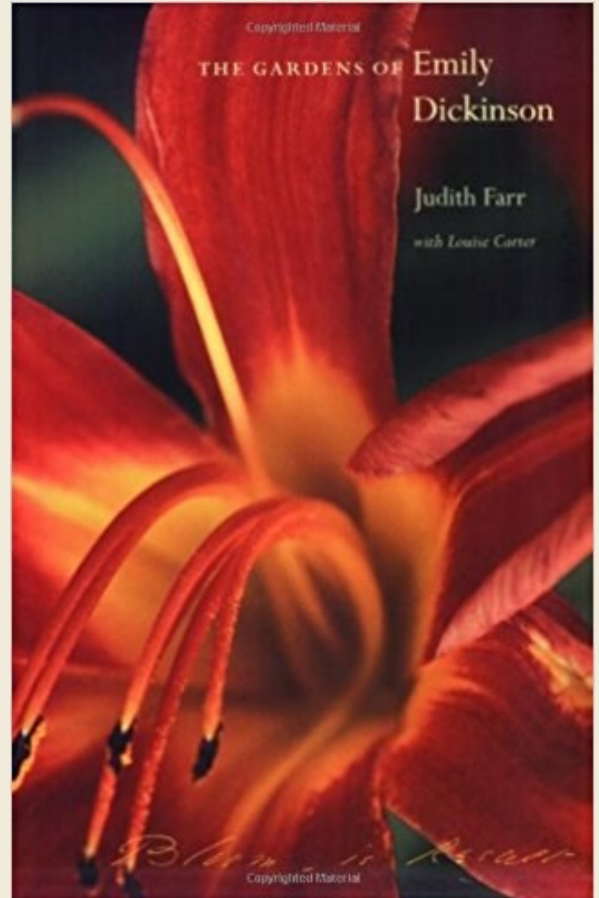


DISCUSSION OF
