Biographical Note	The S.S. Galesburg was christened in 1918, and launched from Shooters Island, New York. It was built under order of Woodrow Wilson as part of an emergency fleet of freighters built to deliver supplies to France during World War One. Records show that the ship was sold to the then-Soviet Union in the 1930s.
Scope & Content	The S.S. Galesburg Carpenter's Log Books collection includes notes from the S.S. Galesburg's carpenter for the years 1920-1921.
