Biographical Note	The Galesburg Club was founded in 1885 with the purpose of promoting business ventures and social enjoyments of its members. The Club was originally in the former Bank of Galesburg building on Main and Kellogg, but acquired their own facilities on Main and Ferris in 1909, and opened in 1911. The club originally had 5 tiers of membership: resident, non-resident, women, junior, and honorary. As an official club no political nor religious views were to be expressed. The Club came to a close due to low membership and accumulated debt, it shut down in the 1960s.	
Scope & Content	The Galesburg Club collection includes treasurers' and secretary reports (box 1), records, members lists, and miscellaneous documents (box 2), and minutes (boxes 2-5) from the years 1898-1966.
