Biographical Note	Holland died in Galesburg hospital on August 2, 1966 after an illness that lasted several weeks. He was born in Galesburg April 15, 1878 and was educated at the Knox Academy at Knox College. In fall 1899 he transferred to Dartmouth and graduated in 1900. He was a member of Phi Delta Theta. Holland lived in Galesburg his entire life, except for 1915-18 when he lived in California. He married Beulah M. Hunt in 1909, and she died in 1921. Holland "was an avid sportsman and a lover of the great outdoors." He was a member of the sporting goods firm of McLean and Holland, had an interest in stock breeding, and was an ornithologist with a keen interest in nesting and migration habits of birds. He was a member of numerous scientific ornithologist societies, as well as a charter member of the Galesburg Rotary Club. He was an excellent tennis player.
