<b>Biographical Note</b>	<a href="#">The Euterpean</a> Club was founded in 1896 and is one of the original 11 clubs in the General Federation of Women's Clubs - Fort Worth. The Euterpean Club is named after the Greek goddess of music Euterpe. The club belongs to the National Federation of Music Clubs, which creates programs to study and enjoy music of different varieties.
<b>Scope &amp; Content</b>	The Euterpean Club collection includes minutes (box 1), programs (box 2), expenditure notices, and miscellaneous documents (box 3) from the years 1891-1900.
