Biographical Note	Townships are the oldest form of government in North America, brought with the pilgrims in 1636. The first townships were established in Illinois in 1850. Townships generally have 8 officers elected for 4 year terms. Knox County is divided into 20 townships and 1 coterminous township - that being the City of Galesburg. An annual meeting of township electors takes place on the second Tuesday in April.
Scope & Content	The Galesburg Township - Men's Votes collection includes poll books and tally sheets for the years 1914-1916.
