Biographical Note	Galesburg State Research Hospital was built in 1943, originally for wounded soldiers returning from World War Two. In 1955, Dr. Harold Himwich developed Chlorpromazine at this hospital. The hospital used all forms of treatment in its history, including insulin and ECT shock therapy. The hospital closed in 1985.
Scope & Content	The Uxores Society collection includes correspondences (folder 1), cards and pamphlets (folder 2), articles (folder 3), notes (folder 4), minutes, and a president's notebook (folder 5) from the years 1959-1972.
